A CLEANSWEEP IS A SPECIAL SCHEDULED COLLECTION OF UNWANTED, UNUSED, DAMAGED, RESTRICTED OR BANNED HOUSEHOLD AND AGRICULTURAL WASTES.

Friday, Aug. 14 – 10 a.m. - Noon – Hawkins Village Park
Friday, Aug. 14 – 3 p.m. - 5 p.m. – Big Bend Town Hall
Sat., Aug. 15 – 10 a.m. - 2 p.m. – Rusk Co. Highway Shop

NO CHARGE:

- **Households – up to 70 pounds of hazardous material**
- **Farmers - up to 200 pounds of agricultural hazardous waste**

(Pre-registration is necessary for agricultural clean sweep and for households with large quantities by calling 715-635-2197.)

FEE BASIS:

- **Businesses (VSQG) Pre-registration required. Reasonable Fees.**

Acceptable Items Include: acetone, aerosol cans (FULL ONLY), antifreeze, artist's paints, auto body repair products, battery acid, brake fluid, button batteries, some car wax, contact cement, driveway sealer, fertilizer, fiberglass epoxy, floor care products, freon, fungicide, furniture polish, gasoline & other fuels, solvent-based glue, hair remover, household cleaners, insect spray, lighter fluid, metal polish, mothballs, nail polish & remover, oil base paint, oven cleaner, paint thinner, paint stripper, parts cleaner, pesticides, pool chemicals, rat poison, alkaline & rechargeable batteries, shellac, shoe polish, spot remover, stain, stump remover, transmission fluid, turpentine, varnish, weed killer, wood filler, wood preservative.

Not Acceptable: Motor oil, alkaline batteries, Freon 11 & 12, explosives, ammunition, radioactive material, compressed gas cylinders, infectious or medical waste.

BUSINESS FEES
