NO CHARGE:

- **Households – no limit of hazardous material**
- **Farmers – up to 200 pounds of agricultural hazardous waste**



REASONABLE FEE: Pre-registration required – Call 715-635-2197

- **Businesses (VSQG)**
- **Farmers – quantity greater than 200 pounds**

Acceptable Items Include: acetone, aerosol cans (empty ones too), 1# propane tanks, antifreeze, artist's paints, auto body repair products, battery acid, brake fluid, button batteries, some car wax, contact cement, driveway sealer, fertilizer, fiberglass epoxy, floor care products, liquid Freon, fungicide, furniture polish, gasoline & other fuels, solvent-based glue, hair remover, household cleaners, insect spray, lighter fluid, metal polish, mothballs, nail polish & remover, oil base paint, oven cleaner, paint thinner, paint stripper, parts cleaner, pesticides, pool chemicals, rat poison, shellac, shoe polish, spot remover, stain, stump remover, transmission fluid, turpentine, varnish, weed killer, wood filler, wood preservative. **NO LATEX PAINT!**

Not Acceptable: Motor oil, alkaline batteries, latex paint, scrap metal, Freon 11 & 12, explosives, ammunition, radioactive material, compressed gas cylinders, infectious or blood-tainted medical waste.

\$2.50	Tires 13 inches to 15 inches
\$5.00	Tires 16 to 19 inches
\$170/ton	Tires 20" and greater
\$170/ton	Government or Residential large quantity rate
\$170/ton	Business Rate (must also pay tax)

Those that bring tires w/rims, large quantities, or tires 20" and greater will have to be weighed and pay price per pound.

Sharps must be placed by owner into provided containers. We WILL NOT accept full sharps containers.
