





Harvesting Prescription

Select Cut Area - Selectively harvest all trees that have been individually marked with orange paint. In addition, harvest all aspen, white birch, and ironwood which is 5" or greater in diameter at D.B.H. Utilize all sawlogs to a 10" top D.I.B., and all pulpwood to a 4" top D.I.B. The skidding of cut forest products, which are greater in length than 17', is prohibited. The use of a slasher or a grapple skidder in the harvesting operation is prohibited. Damage to the residual stand is also prohibited.

Aspen Coppice Area - Harvest all aspen, white birch, and northern hardwood within the designated timber sale area which is 5" or greater in diameter at D.B.H. Utilize all trees that will make one or more 100" pulp sticks to a 4" top D.I.B. All conifer, oak, cherry tree species, and hawthorne should be left uncut and undamaged to add diversity to the regenerated stand. All slash must be lopped and scattered. All other residual non-merchantable hardwood tree species must be cut concurrently with the removal of all merchantable wood products.

Seed Tree Area - Harvest all aspen, white birch and ash trees. Utilize all sawlogs to a 10" top D.I.B., and all pulpwood to a 4" top D.I.B. The skidding of cut forest products, which are greater in length than 17', is prohibited. The use of a slasher or a grapple skidder in the harvesting operation is prohibited. Damage to the residual stand is also prohibited. Special care must be taken to minimize damage to the 1-5" size class.

Seasonal Restrictions for Oak Wilt

Oak Wilt has been confirmed to be present within Rusk County. Because this timber sale contains a significant oak component which will be retained post-harvest, no harvesting will be allowed from April 15th to July 15th in accordance with Rusk County's Oak Wilt Restrictions.

Integrated Resource Considerations

There will be a residual stand of evenly spaced, high quality northern hardwood and oak tree species as well as scattered residual oak and conifer tree species within the aspen regeneration area and scattered northern hardwood species and conifer in the seed tree areas to reduce the visual impact of this timber sale. All existing and future logging roads must be kept free of slash and logging debris. Any new forest road location or construction is subject to review and approval by the County Forest Administrator. All designated snowmobile trails used by the contractor during the harvesting operation must be kept open, free of slash and logging debris, and snow covered. Any slash or logging debris accumulated on the landings must be lopped and scattered. Equipment operation within any established Riparian Management Zone (RMZ), as indicated on the timber sale map, is prohibited. Depositing slash and/or logging debris in any wetland or RMZ is also prohibited. 


RUSK COUNTY FOREST



Selectively harvest all trees that have been individually marked with orange paint. In addition, harvest all aspen, white birch, and ironwood which is 5" or greater in diameter at D.B.H. Utilize all sawlogs to a 10" top D.I.B., and all pulpwood to a 4" top D.I.B. The skidding of cut forest products, which are greater in length than 17', is prohibited. The use of a slasher or a grapple skidder in the harvesting operation is prohibited. Damage to the residual stand is also prohibited. This area must be completed by October 31, 2018.

Blowdown Salvage Area

Salvage all trees within the designated timber sale area which have been damaged due to excessive wind. Due to the fact that this is a wind damage salvage sale, this area must be completed by October 31, 2017.

Oak Wilt Restrictions


