

## RUSK COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS USER RATES

### Security Deposit

A security deposit of \$250.00 per day of use shall be required of all groups using the Fairgrounds to be refunded at the end of the year/event if no problems occurred. The deposit will be returned after inspection by Rusk County Maintenance staff. The deposit shall be forfeited when any of the causes for termination for use are violated.

### User Fees

All groups must pay for usage in advance. If the amount of days or buildings changed from your initial request, a refund or invoice will be mailed to you after the event. Insurance verification, security deposit and rental fees shall be given to the UW Extension office preferably within 30 days prior to event but no later than five (5) business days ahead of scheduled event. **Usage confirmation will not be given until fees, insurance and security deposit are submitted.**

### Set-up Fees

Half price fees shall be charged for all set-up dates. Fees will only be charged for buildings or areas of the grounds that you will be using on set-up dates.
